



ASKO WASHING MACHINES

In a world where it seems that new technology only means more noise, more pollution, and more bother, it's a relief to welcome a product that's both quiet and stingy in its use of limited global resources. Not surprisingly, this new product comes from Sweden.

Asko, Inc. is a Swedish company that has done wonders with the design and manufacture of quality "white goods"--washing machines, tumble dryers, and dishwashers. Though at the higher end of the price scale, these products excel in three important criteria: they are quality engineered and manufactured, they produce very little noise (especially important with dishwashers), and they use a remarkably small amount of water.

The Asko washing machine, a front loading model, heats its own water, which means that it isn't dependent upon the family hot water heater.

Washing can be done at much higher temperatures--up to 203° Fahrenheit vs. the standard 140° most hot water heaters function at. Higher temperatures wash out stains more effectively and reduce the need for harsh detergents and bleach.

The second technological attraction to the Asko washing machine is its spin cycle which boasts a speed of 1500 rpm, much faster than the 600-700 rpm for top-loaders. Spinning laundry at the optimum speed of 1500 rpm removes 94% of the moisture that can be removed by spinning, reducing the time needed in the clothes dryer.

But what makes environmentalists especially happy is that the Asko washing machine uses only 11-17 gallons of water per load, while leading top-loaders consume over 50 gallons at a time. Asko estimates that a family using its washing machine can save enough

water to fill a swimming pool in one year!

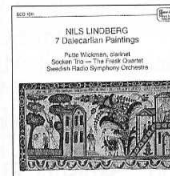
